This essay must also address the applicant's financial need for scholarship.
- Students must have demonstrated involvement in community/CBFO volunteer work, extra-curricular
 activities, and student organization, voting education, and church/religious organizations. Please attach a
 description of your involvement in these activities.
- 4. Copy of transcripts from each school attended as applicable. Qualification is determined by such factors as academic record (Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale), potential performance, need for assistance, and interest in community/public service.
- 5. Letter of recommendation from current instructor or advisor.
- 6. Signed form stating minimum of 10 hours of volunteer work with CBFO sports during senior year.
- I. The following describes the time line for receipt of applications, the selection process, and award of scholarships:
 - Applications and enclosures are due to CBFO UPS mailbox, on or before March 32, 2018, for pickup by one
 of the CBFO Commissioners. Address is: CBFO, P.O. Box 24441, Knoxville, TN 37933.
 - 2. The CBFO Commissioners and Selection Subcommittee will complete their review using a point scoring rating of the applications and make recommendations.
 - 3. The CBFO Commissioners, through the will of its members, which has the final authority, will make the final selection of the recipient(s).
 - 4. The CBFO Commissioners will announce the scholarship awardees soon after the final selections. The CBFO Commissioners will provide a notification to the selected candidate(s) soon after the selection. The award is expected to be announced in May 2018.
 - 5. Completion of items in Section I does not guarantee receipt of scholarship monies.
