The following must be received from each candidate:

- 1. Completed CBFO Scholarship application form.
- 2. Submit an essay on the following topic:

How Participation in Youth and High School Sports Influenced Your Character, Academic Pursuits, and Future Career Plans?

The essay must be specific to assure the Selection Subcommittee that the candidate understands the specific topic (with the length between 450-500 words) as well as demonstrating the candidate's writing skills.

- 3. Students must have demonstrated involvement in community/volunteer work (which can include volunteering with CBFO), extra-curricular activities, student organizations, and church/religious organizations. Please attach a description of your involvement in these activities.
- 4. Copy of transcripts from each school attended as applicable. Qualification is determined by such factors as academic record (minimum required Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale), potential performance, need for assistance, and interest in community/public service.
- 5. Letter of recommendation from current instructor, coach, teacher or school administrator.
- 6. Signed letter from a non profit, 501c(3)-designated organization stating a minimum of ten (10) hours of volunteer work has been completed during the candidate's senior year. At least five (5) of the required volunteer hours must be completed with CBFO and must be completed before the scholarship award is received. Please have the organization if the organization is not CBFO provide a contact name and phone number in the letter. CBFO volunteer hours will be documented on Page 4 of this package. If you have questions about obtaining CBFO volunteer hours, please contact Van Jones (esjones@firsthorizon.com) or one of the CBFO sports commissioners on the final page of this package.

The following describes the time line for receipt of applications, the selection process, and award of scholarships:

1. Applications and enclosures are due to CBFO post office box on or before April 15, 2024. The mailing address is:

- 2. The CBFO Commissioners and Selection Subcommittee will complete their review using a point scoring rating of the applications and make recommendations to the CBFO Board.
- 3. The CBFO Board, through the will of its members, which has the final authority, will make the final selection of the recipient(s).
- 4. The CBFO Commissioners will announce the scholarship recipients and provide a notification to the selected candidate(s) soon after the selection. The award is expected to be communicated in May 2024.
- 5. Completion of items in Section I does not guarantee receipt of scholarship monies.
